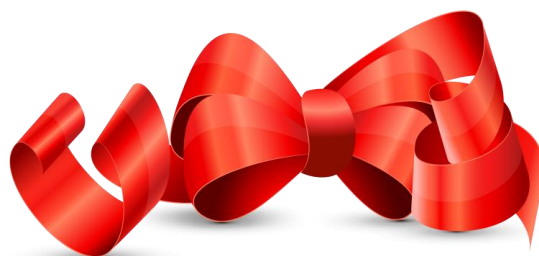

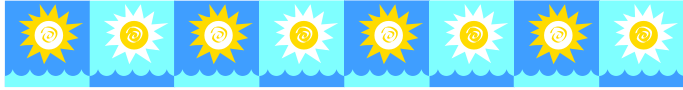

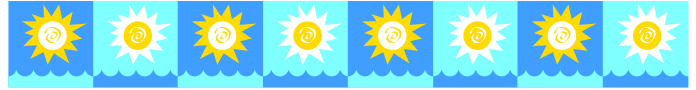
Speaking of checking the website and directory, please ensure your RV space # is listed there.

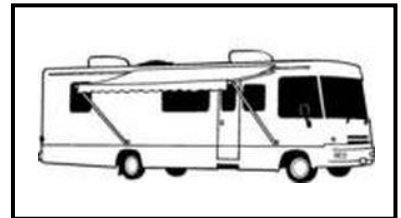
