RV Wheelers Club: 60 Years Strong

From Leisure Wheelers to RV Wheelers of Laguna Woods, CA

The RV Wheelers Club, originally known as the Leisure Wheelers, began its journey in Laguna Woods, California. The club was founded on February 10, 1966, when a small group of local residents with a passion for recreational vehicles and travel came together to share their experiences and organize group trips. Their first meeting was held in the Laguna Woods Village Clubhouse 1, sparking the creation of a community dedicated to RV adventures and camaraderie.

As membership grew and the name of the community changed from Leisure World to Laguna Woods Village the club officially changed its name from Leisure Wheelers to RV Wheelers in 2007. At its inception, the club had about a small number of enthusiastic members. Today, the RV Wheelers Club boasts over 100 active members, reflecting its popularity and the enduring appeal of RV travel among Laguna Woods residents.

The Club will commemorate its 60th anniversary this February. Our mission is to exchange experiences, disseminate knowledge, provide education, and offer community support.

Beware of Critters In the RV Lot!

If you are using your RV and leaving your car in one of the Village RV lots, be aware that there are rodents who may make themselves at home in your car's engine compartment, and they like to chew on the wiring harness. One way to keep them away is to spray peppermint oil, such as Rodent Sheriff. Another option is to use a battery operated Animal Repeller, which mounts in the engine compartment. When a rodent comes in, the repeller flashes a light and emits an ultrasound which drives them away. These precautions are much cheaper than a new wiring harness!


