

We have reserved 15 sites. Full hookups, 30 & 50 amp, cable and picnic tables. All RV's or trailers must fit into a 25 ft by 40 ft site.

You may possibly extend your stay two days prior and two days after the group's scheduled nights at the group rate price. If group sites are not available, you may be required to move. <u>Campsite reservations are available online</u> or by calling our camping experts at the Arizona State Parks Reservation Desk 1-877-MY PARKS. We're available seven days a week from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Arizona time. There is a \$5 non-refundable reservation fee per campsite.

The office at Lost Dutchman is open until 7 p.m. for campsite check-in, but after hours (with campsite reservations) you can grab a map by the ranger station and head straight to your campsite! If you are staying multiple nights, check in with the camp host or a ranger to get a vehicle tag.

The campground has 138 sites: 68 sites with electric (50/30/20 amp service) and water and the remainder non-hookup sites on paved roads for tents or RVs. Every site has a picnic table, and a fire pit with adjustable grill gate. There are no size restrictions on RVs. Well-mannered pets on leashes are welcome, but please pick after your pets.

There is a \$15.00 per night fee for second vehicles. The fee will be paid upon arrival at the park. The fee does not apply to vehicles towed behind a primary vehicle when the primary vehicle remains at the site and the towed vehicle is used for transportation.

Arizona cabin rental options are available throughout the state...Adventure is just a short drive away.

#### RV WHEELERS 2/13/2020 GENERAL MEETING MINUTES

The first page contains a heading with various items to click on. Below the heading, there is a President's Message, followed by a discussion of recent events completed, and a column describing upcoming events (rallies and meetings) through September of this year. Page 1 contains a link to get Club Application and Renewal Forms. The heading on page 1 lists items you can click on to find out detailed Club information. The items include: Home; Club Classified (rigs and equipment); Contact Us (officers and chairpersons); etc; Favorite Links; Members Only (requires a password for security); Newsletters (past and present); and Past Rallies. The Members Only area contains the Membership Directory (available to print out) with the type of information previously contained in the previous Directories (members pictures, anniversaries, rig type/size, storage location, etc.). Mark and Ron requested that members review their information in the last Directory for accuracy, and report any corrections/changes to Mark quickly. A new Directory will be published in March.

Mark showed a picture of the new RV Wheeler display box located on the front patio of Clubhouse 1. Thanks to Mark for fabricating this attractive box.


