How Can You Help During A Disaster?

When a disaster strikes (think fire, earthquake, sliding hillsides, fallen trees during a wind storm, electrical transformers exploding in underground vaults, etc.), what can you do to help your neighbors?

Let me give you a hint. Here in the Village, we have many people who have medicine which must be kept cold. We have many people on oxygen generators that need electricity to run. You and your RV could easily come to the rescue for these types of emergencies. Would you make the fridge in your rig available to store medicine that needs to be kept cold? Would you run an electrical cord to someone that needs oxygen? Would you let a ham radio operator sit under your awning? Hams pass critical information to the Emergency Operations Center (both in the Village and to the County when appropriate). You would become part of the Disaster Response Team.

Years ago, I pulled together a list of Wheelers who were willing to make their RV's available for assignment by Security Division during an emergency. If there's an emergency, Security will go down the list and assign RV's to park in needed locations within the Village. No one will enter your RV. You might be asked to start your generator or store medicine in your refrigerator. When things come back under control, you take your rig back to the lot. That's it.

Are you willing to be "on call" to help your neighbors? I will be collecting names at the next meeting. If you are not able to attend the meeting and still want to participate, email me at mikeepstein@comline.com and I will add your name to the list. Last time I did this, we got 15 rigs participating and we were never used. But, we were available if needed.
