RV WHEELERS LAKE SKINNER RALLY

NOVEMBER 14-18, 2021 \$100 for 4 nights

Lake Skinner Campground, 37701 Warren Road, Winchester, CA, Approx. 1,500' elevation

We have reserved 16 spaces at beautiful Lake Skinner, located near Temecula in Riverside County, 12 miles southwest of Hemet and **only 80 miles from Laguna Woods**. Tucked in the Auld Valley of the Tocalota Hills, Lake Skinner spreads across 1400 surface acres. The lake is operated by the Metropolitan Water District of So. California. Anglers enjoy fishing for bass, carp, trout, catfish, and bluegill. There is no body-contact allowed in the lake, but boating is popular. A marina provides rentals. There is a well stocked camp store too.

This time we will be going on Sunday and coming home on Thursday. **The \$100 price for the four nights is dependent on getting 16 rigs!** If fewer rigs go, the cost will be slightly higher per rig. Spaces have 30 amp electricity, water, a fire pit and picnic table (but no sewer hookup; however, there is a free dump station for the use of campers). There are coin operated showers. No ground fires allowed; Use of BBQ and/or fire ring permitted.
