John's hobbies include woodworking and playing chess, mine include gardening, yoga and music. We both enjoy hiking, kayaking and camping.



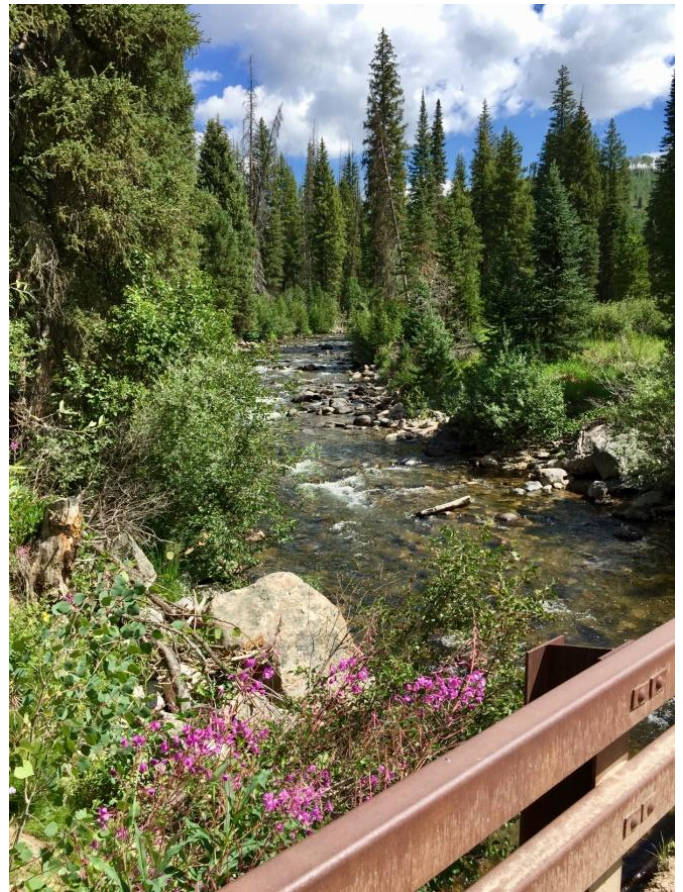

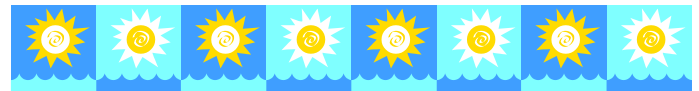

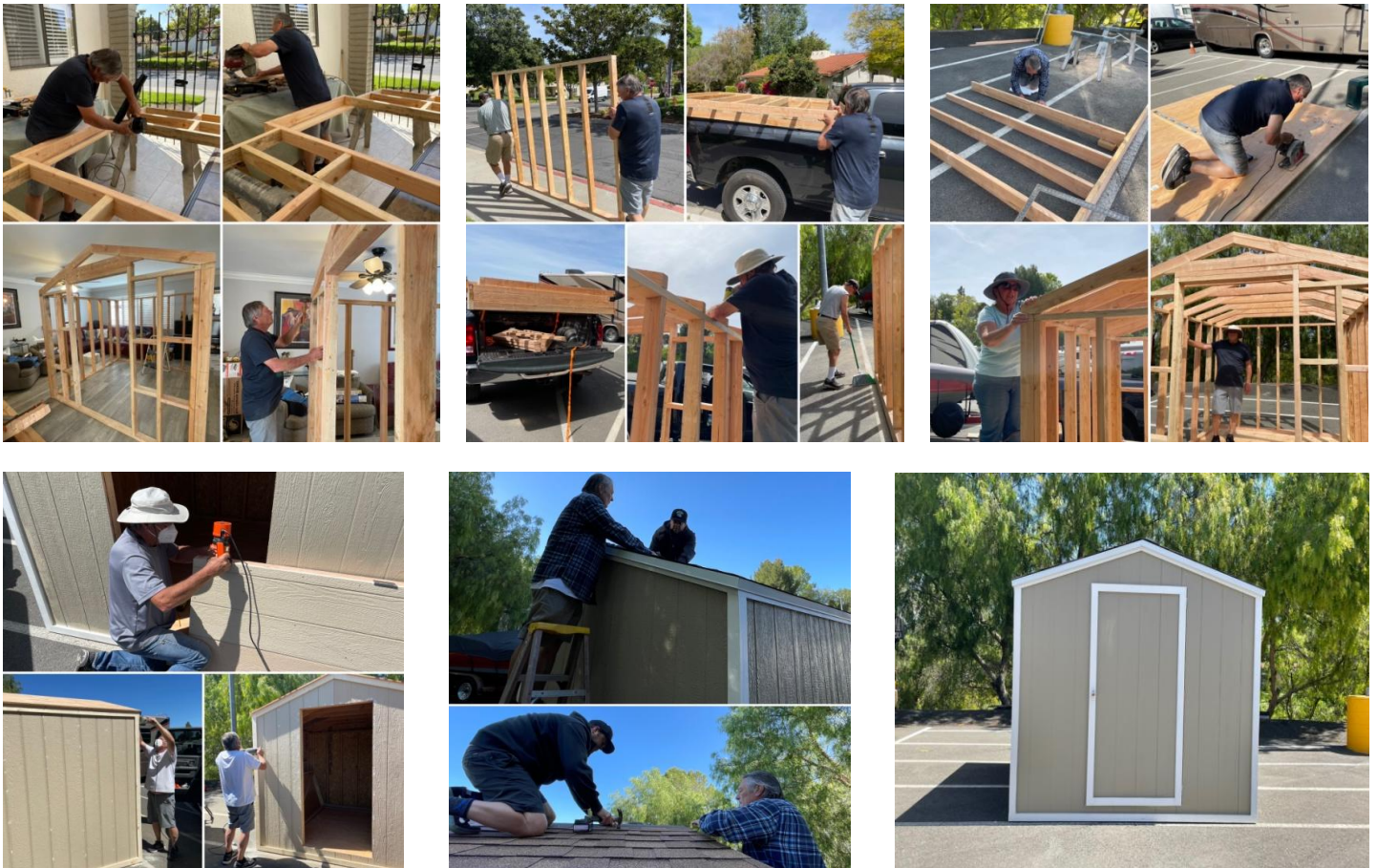
