May and June found several Wheelers headed out on the road for several months.


Our President, Bunny Quartararo, is in Idaho staying with her daughter's family.



Bill and Patti Clover traveled to the Tiffin Rally in Rock Springs, Wyoming with Kevin Clover and Suzanne Olsson-Clover.



Crossing the Continental Divide over Wolf Creek Pass was a gorgeous drive!




Treasure Falls and Rio Grande River camping and fishing.

Lake Skinner Campground, 37701 Warren Road, Winchester, CA, Approx. 1500' elevation

We have reserved 16 spaces at beautiful Lake Skinner, located in Riverside County, 12 miles southwest of Hemet and **only 80 miles from Laguna Woods**. Tucked in the Auld Valley of the Tocalota Hills, Lake Skinner spreads across 1400 surface acres. The lake is operated by the Metropolitan Water District of So. California. Anglers enjoy fishing for bass, carp, trout, catfish, and bluegill. There is no body-contact allowed in the lake, but boating is popular. A marina provides rentals. There is a well stocked camp store too.

This time we will be going Friday and coming home on Tuesday November 1. **The price for the four days is dependent on getting 16 rigs! The cost will be a bit higher if we do not fill all 16 spaces,** Sites have 30 amp electricity, water, a fire pit and picnic table (but no sewer hookup; however, there is a free dump station for the use of campers). There are coin operated showers. No ground fires allowed; use BBQ or fire ring.

We will provide a packet prior to departure with more information for those who will be going. We need to have your reservations and money by **October 1**.
