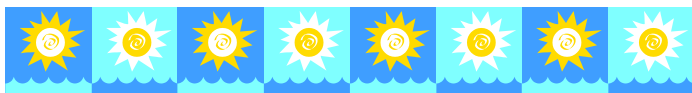

and mechanics who would charge us double.



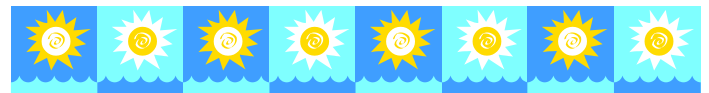

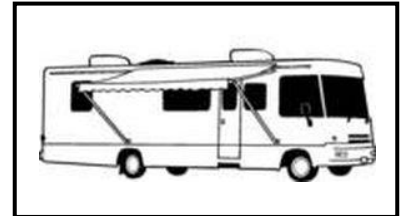
