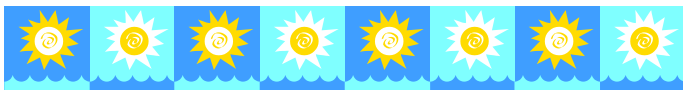


Security will be doing another audit of the RV lots / spaces after the 1<sup>st</sup> of the year.

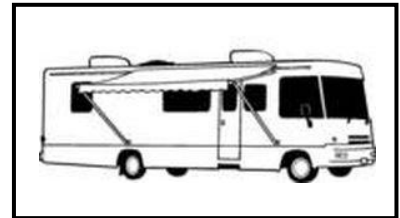
