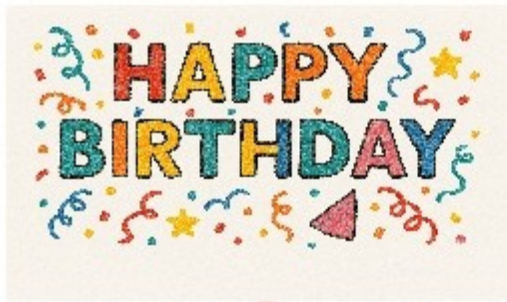
Monday featured trips to the Atomic and Neon museums

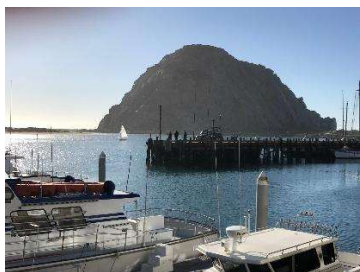

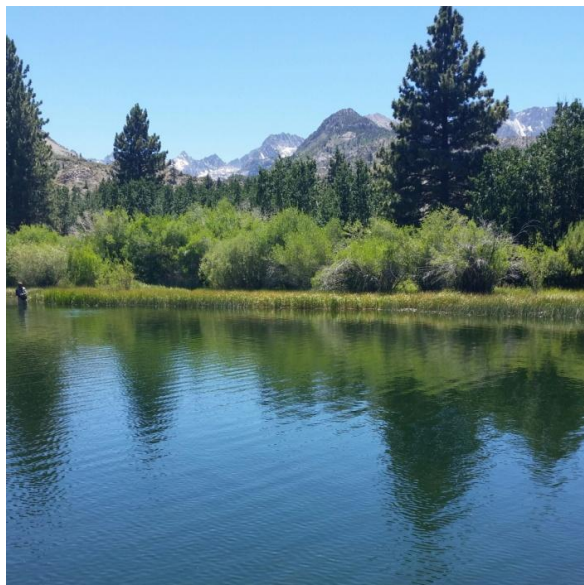
