There is an Amtrack station very close if you would like to visit venues in San Diego without the expense of parking and fuel. Senior round trip fares are inexpensive. The Elks Lodge is ideally situationed to visit the Wild Animal Park, and many wineries and casinos (Valley View is fairly close).


