Couple of Tips for the RV Oven

Many of you likely know the tip of using a pizza, baking stone or unglazed ceramic tile in the RV oven to help even out the heating and prevent burning the bottom of things. I prefer the <u>pizza stone</u> as I can also use it for its intended purpose. The only problem is I broke my first one into pieces traversing some rough roads. My solution is a "kill two birds with one stone type." Hmm, could be a pun in there somewhere. \bigcirc I use the oven to store our thick wooden cutting board and the extra weight on the pizza stone solved the breakage problem. BTW, the oven is a great extra storage place.

Another tip I have is to layer the bottom in aluminum foil as we do for the outside grill. Oven grease and food droppings collect on the foil, helps speed oven clean up time.

HEADS UP SO YOU CAN PLAN AHEAD!!!

We have a very busy fall camping schedule:

October 12-18: Aqua Caliente Park, Julian

You have to make your own reservations for this one. We are going to Aqua Caliente County Park for six nights. Perfect during the winter and spring, located near the south end of Anza-Borrego Desert State Park. Best known for its geothermally heated springs, the park attracts visitors eager to soak in the soothing mineral waters. Spectacular vistas while lounging around camp, hiking miles of trails or taking a leisurely sunset or sunrise walk. Spectacular starry nights. Those wishing, can take a drive into Borrego Springs to enjoy the State Park Visitor Center or join in a park sponsored nature walk, or go shopping, or have lunch in the little village of Borrego Springs.

Since the County of San Diego requires full payment ahead, booking even just 10 sites would require quite an outlay from our treasury, so we are asking those who want to go to book their sites individually and let us know which site you have booked. So far we have 7 spots signed up around the 70-85 area. Soon, we will be sending out more information about the campground and the requirements so you can take a look. Since it is a popular winter spot, we don't advise waiting too long to book your spot. If you book this far out and later have to cancel, the cancellation fee is pretty nominal if you cancel 30 days or more ahead. <u>Call 858-565-3600</u> to make reservations. November 5 to 12: Distant Drums RV Resort, Camp Verde, AZ. - A CDRV rally organized by George and Rita Gorss (former Wheelers) who will be the Wagon Masters. All Members of the Laguna Woods RV Wheelers, the Sun City Palm Desert RV Club and the Desert Drifters RV Club of the Indio Elks Lodge (to all of which they belong) are invited to join).

<u>7 nights, Monday to Monday.</u> The Camp Verde, AZ. Resort is about 20 minutes from Sedona on Route 17. The Resort has 30/50 amp service, free Wi-Fi, cable, showers, a library, meeting rooms, heated pool and spa, a dedicated doggie area and a store. The sites we will have will all be back-ins, unless otherwise requested by you. The back-in sites will cost \$36.00 plus tax per night. <u>A fee of \$5.00 per rig is payable to George or Rita for the "fun fund" to cover some of the costs for game prizes</u>. No dog/cat fees. Make your reservation with George 714-926-9897 or Rita 714-809-3802, (not the Resort). No deposit is necessary at this time. November 12-17: Sam's Family Spa, Desert Hot Springs


EAST SHORE RALLY
