The biggest issue on my mind at this point is the rally schedule for 2018. Ed really needs members to step up and volunteer to host or co-host and recommend venues. We are open to different types of camping from plush (like Chula Vista and Emerald Desert) to more rustic places (maybe even boon docking). We'd like to throw in some weekend camping as many of our members still work; maybe Friday-Tuesday or something like that. But for right now, if you pay before January 1, it's only \$15/person (\$30/couple).






