This assignment of rallies is only a suggestion. Our by-laws specify that each club member should host a rally at least once in 3 years.

- 2. If you have a month/year conflict, you may trade with any other club member. Please call the Wagon Master to confirm, reschedule or decline well in advance of your assigned month.
- 3. There will always be experienced people to help in any way, so keep that in mind.

I am suggesting you do the following to prepare:

- 4. Be sure the Wagon Master provides you with a copy of the Rally Host's and Assistant's job description. Find an assistant or co-host. It is suggested you find somebody who will be happy to help you provided you will be their co-host when their month comes up.
- 5. At least six months out pick a camp ground and make reservations for 10-15 rigs. Try not to conflict with the monthly meeting of the club, if possible. Determine a cost for the rally which would be the nightly rate (including taxes) plus \$10-\$20 per rig for club provided food items and/or prizes. You can discuss this with the Wagon Master.
- 6. Get a contract from the camp ground and find out your cancel down date (the last date you can cancel your reservations for the camp sites that have not been reserved by a club member). Also make arrangements for a club room, if possible.
- 7. Contact the Treasurer and make arrangements for the club to pay the deposit or put it on your miles/reward credit card and get a reimbursement from the Treasurer. Make sure the Treasurer gets a copy of the contract.

- 8. Prepare a simple one-page flyer with a reservation coupon attached. Discuss it with the Wagon Master and get it in the hands of the newsletter editor. The first publication should be at least 4 months prior.
- 9. Plan any activities such as game night, or a LEO NIGHT (Let's Eat Out), or any dinner or breakfast pot lucks.
- 10. The Wagon Master can provide you with Information and check sheets to help you get and stay organized.
- 11. There will be monthly contact with the Wagon Master to resolve any questions or problems.

Stay tuned more to follow, but this will get you started. Happy Trails.

Now those who still work can join us for the weekend. We will leave on Friday, October 12 (check in time is 2 PM) and come home on Thursday, October 18 or any day you choose (check out time is Noon). The cost is \$33/nite for full hookups plus a \$5 reservation fee (\$29 + \$5 for partial hookups). Cabins are also available. PLEASE NOTE YOU HAVE TO MAKE YOUR OWN RESERVATIONS. Try to get in the area of sites 70-90 as that is where your hosts plan to be.

The park is a 910-acre San Diego County Park approximately 150 miles from Laguna Woods. Best known for its geothermally heated springs, it attracts visitors eager to soak in the soothing mineral waters. Two naturally fed outdoor pools and an indoor therapeutic spa which is heated to 102 degrees and outfitted with Jacuzzi jets. This desert destination is perfect during the winter and spring and is located near the south end of Anza-Borrego Desert State Park.

Those wishing to take a drive into Borrego Springs (about 45 miles away) can enjoy presentations by volunteer naturalists at a very unique Visitor Center outside town or join in one of the nature walks led by park staff. You could also bird-watch or even go shopping or have lunch in the little village of Borrego Springs or drive into Julian.
